- How did it make you feel?
- Where did you see God?

3. Pastor David shared a quote from Russian author Fyodor Dostoyevsky: 'Loving humility is marvelously strong, the strongest of all things, and there is nothing else like it.' Do you think that's true or false?

- How does his assertion fit with your life experience?
- How might humility be an expression of strength, rather than of weakness?

Action

- What small, tangible act of service can you offer?
- This doesn't need to be anything big—it can be as simple as visiting someone who's lonely or picking up groceries for someone in need.
