
Ash Wednesday Two Online Services February 17 at 12 pm & 6 pm

Online Ash Wednesday service will be available on the Knox website and on our usual streaming platforms.

Ashes will be distributed at Knox from 1:30 - 2:30 pm and 5:00 - 6:00 pm. Ashes will be distributed outside to people in cars as they drive up to the Catalpa entrance. Pastors and Worship Music Arts Council members will be outside on both sides of the cars to distribute the ashes.

Health protocols will be followed with disposable Q-tips being used to avoid cross contamination.

A Lenten devotional will also be distributed as well as downloadable music to play in the car while waiting and for use throughout lent.




