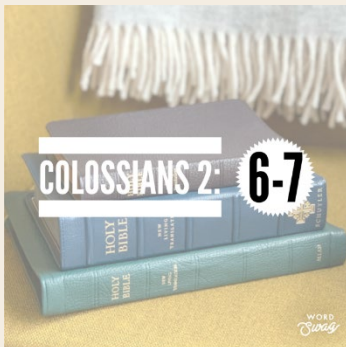

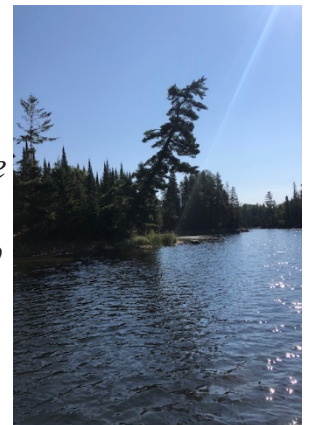

### Read Aloud:

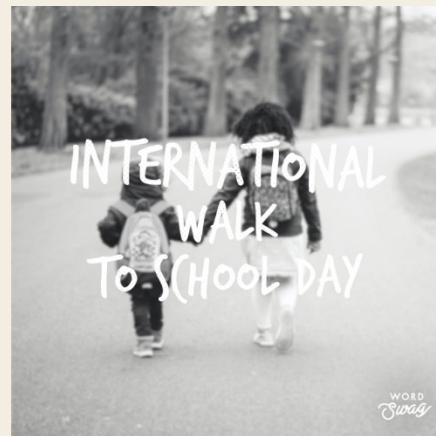
